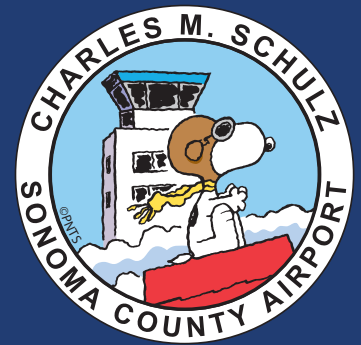



STS Powers-Up Passengers with FuelRod™ Kiosks

Sonoma County Airport now offers the innovative FuelRod kiosks for passengers needing to power up mobile devices on-the-go. The kiosks are located within the Airport terminal and at the gate for convenience and take all major credit cards.

The \$20 portable, rechargeable FuelRod charging system delivers up to 8-hours of talk time on smart phones, or nearly 4-hours of usage on the most demanding of tablet devices. Each come with adapters for both Apple or Android devices.

Environmentally Friendly

Fully rechargeable for repeat usage, FuelRod can be plugged in to any standard electrical outlet using a USB adapter that plugs into both the FuelRod and outlet. However, for no additional cost customers have the handy option of swapping their units out for another fully charged unit at any FuelRod Swap Station (swaps are unlimited). They can also simply return it to a FuelRod station. This means no empty FuelRods in a landfill.

“Public demand for more charging options at the Airport spurred our interest in providing FuelRod. We believe it will be a welcome amenity for passengers needing to stay connected in transit,”

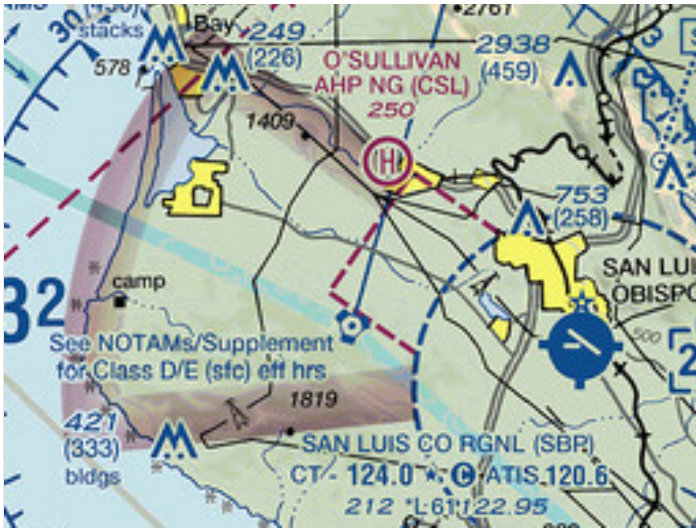

The Oceano County Airport is located just a few minutes walk from some of the most beautiful coastline in California. With easy access to the Pismo Beach dunes, you can walk the beach and enjoy ATV riding, Hummer tours of the dunes, swimming in the ocean, or simply relaxing on the beach sand. Overnight accommodations are made easy with the airport's onsite campground as well as close proximity to a variety of hotels and local vacation property rentals, many of which are located directly on the beach.

History

Oceano Airport was built in the 1950's to serve the communities of Pismo Beach, Oceano and Grover City. This unique airport is within a short walk of the beautiful Pacific Ocean and sandy beaches.

Oceano, in addition to perhaps being the closest airport to the Pacific Ocean, is a vital link in emergency services in San Luis Obispo County. Life-flight, California Highway Patrol, Sheriff Aero Squadron, Civil Air Patrol, Diablo Canyon evacuation, Beach rescues, Arroyo Grande Community Hospital, Angel Flights, CalStar all make use of Oceano airport. It is a great field for training and is used by regional CFIs. Many clubs also have annual events at L52-Oceano.

Campground Information

Campgrounds are Fly-In use only, and are directly adjacent to the tarmac. Firepits are available, and restrooms are located in the terminal.

Schedule your Badge Appointments Online

The Sonoma County Airport website is now equipped with an application for badge holders to schedule their badging appointments online.

To schedule your next appointment, please go to the Sonoma County Airport website at flysts.com and click the Business and Community Tab at the top of the page. Scroll down and click on the Badges link, then select the type of badge you require.

Once you have reviewed the pre-authorization requirements, you can choose which appointment you need and select from the available times. You will receive a confirmation e-mail once your appointment has been finalized.

Badge holders who do not wish to book online may still continue to schedule their appointments over the phone. Badge Authorizations must still be conducted by the company or tenant Authorized Signer prior to booking an appointment, so please make sure your badge sponsorship has been secured prior to booking your appointment.

The SIDA badge description states that the SIDA is a restricted ground area of the airport that can only be accessed by those who possess a valid SIDA badge, and that AOA badge holders are not authorized to operate in the SIDA at any time.

Airport Dumpsters, Recycling & Oil Recycling

The Airport provides dumpsters, recycling bins and oil recycling for the use of Airport hangar and tiedown tenants for waste generated on the Airport. The Airport Manager's office has been receiving complaints that vehicles are entering from outside the Airport and dumping large amounts of trash from off the Airport and overfilling the dumpsters.

Per County Ordinance No. 6090, Sec. 3-4 General rules of conduct (e) No person shall place, dump or abandon any waste, refuse, personal belongings, or any other material anywhere on the Airport premises. Signs posted by the dumpsters also prohibit dumping of any items from outside the Airport. Violations of the Ordinance may result in an Administrative Penalty in the amount of \$100 for the first offense and \$500 for each additional offense.

Catching a Flight?

New Federal Requirements Begin October 1, 2020.

California Department of Motor Vehicles offers federal compliant REAL ID driver license or identification cards starting January 22, 2018.



All valid California driver licenses and identification cards can be used to board domestic flights until October 2020.

You can also use a passport or other TSA approved documents to board a domestic flight.

To apply for a REAL ID card:

- Make an appointment to visit a DMV field office on or after January 22, 2018.
- Provide identity document, such as a U.S. birth certificate, U.S. passport, employment authorization document, permanent resident card or foreign passport with an approved form I-94.
- Provide proof of a social security number.
- Show a California residency document.
- If legal name has changed, may need marriage license or divorce decree.

Note: Those under 18 are not required to have a REAL ID to fly.
