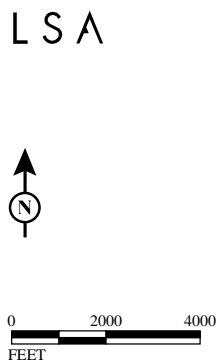


The boundaries of the various occurrences shown on this map do not depict the actual geographic limits of where special status plants or animals are currently found. Rather, circles show an approximate radius of land around one or more historic occurrences, within which the occurrences may be currently found. Other shapes depict an approximate zone within which one or more populations of plants were historically mapped. In some polygons, the historically mapped populations may no longer be extant, or the actual extent of any existing population may be significantly smaller, as is the case withlisted plant species on the Sonoma County Airport site.
